Minutes for 3rd May + update.

- 1 Present - Mesdames: Glazier, Mean.

- 2 Minutes for 5th April - These were signed as a true record.
- 3 Update from last meeting - Richard and I had a meeting with Councillor Alan Bristow, with Ray Whitwell also in attendance. Cllr Bristow had kindly offered to talk us through the funding application forms for Glassmore and Burnthouse Farm. This took place on Wednesday 18th April, and on Friday 21st April a few of us met at Richards' to begin filling in the forms.
- 4 Richard - Richard was able to confirm that our request to Whittlesey Town Council to pay for our Public Liability Insurance had been approved, so a big thank you to them. He also told us that further work was needed to finish the Glassmore application. We therefore met at Richards' on Friday 5th May to finish the form, which was duly done. He is now working to get it approved by Cllr Bristow, as there are a few attachments that need to go with the application. We're working to get these in place, and only then can the application be submitted!
- 5 Civic Day - Robert and I timed our 'walk' at 1hr 15mins, so we've planned to do 2 – at 10am and again at 12midday. Since the meeting we've got the advert out. Lots of our shops have it, all the schools, scouts & guides, WI & U3A have been invited, plus it's due in the next Discovering Whittlesea and The Fens. If it's a nice sunny day, and we get a lot of interest, we may have to consider doing a 3rd 'walk', because we've been getting very favourable comments. We invited Whittlesey Society at their meeting on Monday 8th May. The speaker that night was Dorothy Halfhide, curator of Thorney museum. She asked if we'd be willing to do a 'walk' for Thorney museum members at a later date, so we'll look into the possibilities of doing that for them.
