## Minutes for 7<sup>th</sup> February

- 1 Present - Mesdames: McAndrew, Barback.

- 2 Minutes for 10<sup>th</sup> January - These were signed as a true record.
- 3 Cheque signatory - Our previous chairperson, Annette, had still been a signatory for the group. However, she agrees it's not in the best interests of the group for this arrangement to continue, so wishes for someone else to take this on. Thankfully, David Hancock, our surveyor has agreed to step in.
- 4 Survey document - Katie has composed a foreword which she will send to Anthony Goode of SPAB, to ask him to endorse and sign, so it's almost done.
- 5 Morley's yard planning - I expect you'll all have seen the proposal for a co-op store on Morley's yard at West End. We're leaving our comments online expressing our concerns for the safety of the Grade 2 listed wall at that location.
- 6 Land owners - There are two sites, which have mud walls, which have been developed around the walls, which has meant that the ownership of these walls is now unknown. The first site, 6 Delph St, required a land registry search as there was a dangerous tree. This search also gave us the ownership of 2 walls. For the other site, Finkle Court, Ray was able to provide the planning application number and the name of the developer. I contacted him and the file was checked, but it didn't reveal anything. This search will continue.
- 7 2018 Events / Tourism - There are a number of different events we'll be looking into this year, either looking at our walls, or spreading the word about them. We'll check out the viability of each and decide.
