### CP12/2020 - Agenda Items for discussion

- Allotment waiting list / Roadway / Allocations. Now 12 on the list, the clerk will be offering some more out in the next couple of days, if the process of allocation is being slowed due to feedback from prospective tenants, Cllr Whitwell will offer to meet tenants on site and show them the allotment to speed up the process, the Clerk will see how the next batch of allocations go and report back at the next meeting. The roadway is still an issue, Cllr Mrs Mayor is going to contact P J Thory and see if they can assist with the collection and laying of the plainings. For future meetings, change the heading of this item to 'Allotments'.
- Duck Race 1000 ducks are now counted and numbered, no need to purchase any for this years race. Tickets are being given out to Councillors to sell, they are also on sale from Dawson Florist, Parkers Newsagent and the Town Council Offices. Street selling will be Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020 and Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> April between 9 11 at the Coop and the afternoon of the duck race. The Clerk to write to the Fire service just to remind them (note for Clerk).
