<u>F98/21 Public Forum</u> To allow any member of the public to address the council. Time allowed 15 minutes in total to be split equally between the total amount wishing to speak.

Mr Stephen Robinson – Thanked Cllr Gerstner for the sterling work on his comprehensive website, including COVID statistics, Kings Dyke Bridge, Saxon Pit, MVAS results and scams. At the last zoom meeting the issue of Commons Road was raised as it was in poor condition, very shortly after yellow paint was applied identifying the holes to be repaired, Mr Robertson has duly counted the holes today and even after the repair there are 42 further holes. The repairs that are being carried out cannot be cost effective. Why do CCC not repair the whole road?

MVAS units is it proved that they reduce the speed? Are they cost effective?

Mr Robert Windle – Commented that some of the batteries have run down and the cameras are not working. Fenland Youth Radio has appointed him as Station Manager, David Carr has been appointed the General manager of the new young techs. A daily breakfast show is now going on, it is a trial whilst the football is going on and hopefully will continue after. The Big Bash is the 12^{th of} September, this will not replace the Whittlesey Festival but gives the town something to look forward to before the lead up to Christmas.

F99/21 Agenda items for Discussion.

- 1. Citizens Advice Bureau request for accommodation After discussion Cllr Miscandlon proposed we offer free accommodation; this was seconded by Cllr Gerstner with a unanimous vote in favour. Members asked the Clerk to liaise with the CAB to find the best option.
- 2. Peterborough & Fenland Breastfeeding Group Cllr Miscandlon proposed we offer accommodation; this was seconded by Cllr Whitwell with a unanimous vote in favour. The

Clerk was to contact them regarding availability, also give details of venues in Coates, Eastrea, & Pondersbridge.

- 3. Mayors Charities Cllr Mason advised members of his charities for 2021/22, they are Sue Ryder Thorpe Hall, Community Car Scheme and Whittlesey Sports Association.
- 4. Neighbourhood Plan Cllr Dorling advised members the flier had been produced and was being advertised on the website. Once the consultation documents were produced there would be two open days at Peel House where members of the public could come and view and obtain a copy of the consultation if they had not received one.
- 5. Mud Walls Cllr Whitwell advised that over the last two years, he has been working with Historic England on Mud Walls, previously there had only been two listed in Whittlesey. There are now five additional mud walls that have been given listed status. FDC were asked if they would put every mud wall under an article 4 direction, but FDC put that on hold until the listing process had been finalised. Cllr Whitwell advised he will contact FDC and request an 'Article 4' is put on all remaining mud walls.
- 6. Whittlesey Speed Watch Cllr Mason advised that a new group had been formed and Cllr Cllr Gerstner will be the representative working on this. Cllr Gerstner advised that the group had asked if the Clerk could assist with organisation and coordination of the group, but he has denied this request due to the Clerks workload.
- 7. Council meetings moving forward Cllr Mason next full council meeting on Thursday 22nd July 2021. Community Projects and Planning on 7th July, Finance & Policy and Planning 19th July. No meeting in August, Full council 23rd Sept, but omit the 19^{th of} August meeting the Town Clerk will liaise with the Chair of the various committees, Cllr Gerstner proposed, seconded Nawaz all in favour.

Cllr Miscandlon as FDC Chairman attended the Flag Fen advisory board summer solstice. The new Deputy Mayor of CPCA was present and is incredibly supportive of WTC heritage project.
