

A47 Guyhirn junction Roadworks bulletin February 2022

Progress on our A47 Guyhirn junction scheme

We continue to deliver improvements to the A47 junction and increase the size of the roundabout at Guyhirn, which once complete, will ease congestion and cope with increasing traffic levels.

What's next

The next stage of work includes lining, placing studs on the road, resurfacing, and work to repair the River Nene bridge.

Road closures

- Where: A47 South Brink will be closed between Guyhirn and the A1101 Wisbech roundaboutWhen: 8pm on Friday 4 February to 6am on Monday 7 February
 - 8pm on Friday 11 February to 6am on Monday 14 February.

Diversion route (shown in diagram one):

- Eastbound traffic will follow the A47 west to Peterborough and join theA16 north to Sutterton, then take the A17 east to King's Lynn, and re-join the A47 to return to Guyhirn.
- Westbound traffic will follow this route in reverse.

Where:A47 Fen Road will be closed between Guyhirn and ThorneyWhen:8pm on Friday 18 February to 6am on Monday 21 February8pm on Friday 25 February to 6am on Monday 28 February.

Diversion route (shown in diagram two):

 Eastbound traffic will exit the Whitepost roundabout onto the A1139, then continue onto A605 Fletton Interchange, take the slip road onto the A605 through Whittlesey and Coates to the A141, and re-join the A47 at Guyhirn.

- Westbound traffic will follow this diversion in reverse.
- **Where:** All the approaches to the Guyhirn roundabout (South Brink, Fen Road, and the A141 March Road south to the A605)
- When: 8pm on Friday 4 March to 6am on Monday 7 March 8pm on Friday 11 March to 6am on Monday 14 March 8pm on Friday 18 March to 6am on Monday 21 March.

Diversion route for Fen Road and South Brink diversions (shown in diagrams one and two)

Diversion route for the A141 diversion (shown in diagram three)

- Northbound traffic will take the A605 westbound through Whittlesey towards Peterborough, then take the A1139 and the A15 north to pass Peterborough, and then the A47 eastbound through Thorney to reach the Guyhirn roundabout.
- Southbound traffic will follow this diversion route in reverse.

We try to minimise any disruption during our works, but there may be some unavoidable noise such as reversing bleepers on vehicles.

Residents directly impacted by have been contacted about accessing their property.




Diagram One: Diversion route for A47 South Brink closure

Diagram Two: Diversion route for A47 Fen Road closure






Diagram Three: Diversion route for A141 closure
