P70/2020. To consider Planning Applications received from FDC for comment: -

F/YR20/0661/0 – Erect 3 x dwellings (outline application with all matters reserved) at Land East of 17 Burnthouse Sidings, Turves

The Town Council recommend refusal on the grounds of policy LP12 there is also no justification of the building of these houses in the countryside.

F/YR20/0695/F – Erect a single storey porch extension, and cladding to front of existing dwelling at 352 Benwick Road, Whittlesey

The Town Council have no objection and therefore recommend approval.

F/YR20/0712/F - Erect a part 2 storey, part first floor extension to front and side of existing dwelling at 159 Snowley Park Whittlesey.

The Town Council have no objection and therefore recommend approval.

F/YR20/0730/F – Erect a single-storey extension to side of existing dwelling involving demolition of existing extension and conservatory and removal of chimney at 24 St Marys' Street, Whittlesey.
