(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING)

ORDER 2023/522

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any vehicle from parking / waiting along Broad Street, Whittlesey as lies between number 35 and Thorofare Lane.

During the period this order remains in force The County of Cambridgeshire (Various Streets, Whittlesey) (Traffic Regulations) (Consolidation) Order 1996 Schedule 2.7 - (Waiting limited to one hour in any two hours 8.00am to 6.00pm Mondays to Saturdays), Broad Street - (a) East side from a point 40 metres south of its junction with Whitmore Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 60 metres. (b) West side from a point 25 metres south of its junction with Whitmore Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 77 metres is hereby suspended.

The Order is made to facilitate telecommunication works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 2 May 2023 and continue until these works have finished or on the 1 November 2024 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 2 May and 29 May 2023.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
