NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any vehicle, cyclist, pedestrian and equestrian from proceeding along Whittlesey Byway 31, Whittlesey as lies between Ten Acre Drove and Blackbush Drove.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this order.

The alternative route for vehicles, cyclists, pedestrians and equestrians will be as signed.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
