Whittlesey Festival – Members asked why the committee are invoicing FDC for 11k, Cllr Boden was asked to investigate this. Members suggested the festival committee try to obtain funding from the Arts Council England, Cllr Sennitt-Clough advised through the Chair she would be happy to help them with the process. CPP Marketplace would also be able to assist with the events with the funding they haven allocated from ACE. Cllr Boden proposed at this stage a grant from WTC is not offered, but the Festival meet with Cllr Sennitt-Clough to discuss how they approach ACE.

Mr Page confirmed that match funding was in place, Cllr Mockett proposed £1000.00, seconded Cllr Arman with a majority vote in favour. Cllr Wicks took no part in the discussion or the vote.
