Various Roads, Whittlesey
(Temporary Prohibition Of Through Traffic)
Order 2026-21738

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council intends to make an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 the effect of which is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along various roads, as set out in Schedule 1 below.

Nothing in this Order shall prevent access and egress from premises or land adjacent to the highway mentioned in Schedule 1.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate water mains renewal and associated works which are being carried out on or near this highway.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 2 November 2026 and will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months from the date it comes into effect to permit the works and any associated contingencies including delays or phased delivery of the works.

It is anticipated that this order will apply to the locations, at various times during the dates specified in the Schedule.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
